

Dear Senior and your Parent/Guardian(s),

We are pleased to announce that we will be administering the SAT during our regular school day at Charter Arts on **Wednesday, October 16, 2019**. Similar to this past April, we are excited to offer this opportunity to a limited number of participants (50 students) in the Class of 2020. The October administration of the SATs is well-timed for college application deadlines; especially for students applying to four-year institutions. Keep in mind that many community colleges in the area use SAT scores as a substitute for their placement tests; hence, taking the SAT can be useful experience should you be looking to start your post-secondary education with coursework at a community college.

The SAT we will be proctoring on October 16th, will not include the optional essay portion of the assessment. **The cost of the SAT (without the essay) is \$49.50.** Therefore, for your planning purposes, please review the application requirements of the college/universities on your “Colleges I’m Thinking About” list to determine if you need to submit an SAT essay score or not in the application process. In the event that you are in need of submitting an SAT score with an essay, please refer to the College Board fall calendar of test dates and registration deadlines below:

Students can take the SAT with and without the essay on any of the dates listed above.

The School Counseling Department will open registration for the October 16th administration of the SATs at Charter Arts on September 3, 2019. Registration reservations for the school day SAT are on a first-come, first-serve basis. Unlike the Saturday test dates of the SAT, registration for the school day administration of the SAT is processed directly through Charter Arts’ School Counseling Department. Once again, the cost for the SAT (without the essay) is **\$49.50**, cash or check payable to Charter Arts. Registration for the school day SAT can be processed in the School Counseling Suite of Charter Arts before school and during the lunch block periods. For all test dates, SAT fee waiver vouchers are available for those who qualify. Please contact your School Counselor, if you are in need of a fee waiver for the SAT.
