Dear Charter Arts students and families,

Governor Wolf announced on March 29th that all Pennsylvania schools will be “closed indefinitely”. To that end, Charter Arts will operate under the online learning format until at least April 30th, unless otherwise directed by Governor Wolf. We will continue to update you as we receive information from the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) and the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Senior class, we also know that this is not the senior year you were hoping to have, and our Admin team is starting to discuss end-of-year options. However, we cannot make any final determinations until we have additional information from PDE and the CDC. Yearbooks are still in process, and we will be connecting with you specifically in Google Classroom as we have more information regarding graduation, graduation projects, prom, etc. We will also be updating the Q&A that is posted to our school website under the families tab.

All final exams, both core and artistic, will be cancelled for this school year.

Our building will continue to be closed at this time to all staff and students. While we understand that students and employees may have items in their lockers or classrooms, everyone will need to work with what they have available at home. Students should contact their individual teachers regarding the ability to complete a specific assignment if they do not have access to the necessary materials.

As a reminder, Charter Arts will have one day of Spring Break on Friday, April 10th. Online instruction will resume again on Monday, April 13th. This means that students do not need to log in for attendance on Friday, April 10th nor do they need to submit any work, and teachers will not host office hours or post any assignments due this day.
