Dear Charter Arts faculty, students, and families,

As you may already know, <u>Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf has just announced that all Pennsylvania schools K-12 will be closed for 10 business days</u>, starting on Monday, March 16, 2020, as an effort to thwart the spread of the coronavirus. After the ten-day closure, his administration will evaluate the situation and determine how to proceed from that point.

This ten-day closure is non-instructional, therefore, there will be no remote learning taking place. However, the Charter Arts Administration and faculty met today to plan for any future remote learning if that were to become necessary after this ten-day closure period.

At this time, spring performances at Charter Arts are canceled. More information will be provided as alternatives are discussed through the evolution of this unprecedented situation.
