As we approach the end of the 2019-2020 school year, certainly not in the way that we had hoped or intended, the School Counseling Department is preparing for our end of year tasks and responsibilities. Accordingly, we ask that every senior complete the Class of 2020 Survey in your Naviance Student account by 11:59pm on Friday May 15th.

The "Class of 2020 Survey" is a REQUIRED survey. The School Counseling Department uses the information supplied by your responses to process final Official Transcripts for all of our 2 and 4 year college-bound students in addition to providing press release information of all our graduates to *The Morning Call* and *The Express Times*.

There are several questions that allow you to provide the School Counseling Department with your feedback so that we can continue to improve upon our service the student body of Charter Arts. Further, the Class of 2020 Survey includes a Google Form link so that our college-bound seniors can supply us with scholarship amounts, merit based awards, and financial aid information (Question #13). Any information related to need-based financial assistance will be kept confidential.

Additionally, Question #17 allows those of you who have applied to 2 or 4 year university/college(s), to notify us of your admissions decisions (i.e. accepted/waitlist/decline). We appreciate you all providing us with this information so that we can provide well-informed support to other Charter Arts students in future years.

Directions to access the "Class of 2020 Survey"

1. Login to your Naviance Student account: <https://student.naviance.com/lvchs>
2. Navigate to the "About Me" tab, and select "Surveys to Take"
3. Click on the "Class of 2020 Survey" link
 - a. Question #13 is answered via the Google Form link
 - b. Question #17 uses the "lookup" hyper link
4. Answer any and all applicable questions, and when finished hit "submit"
