As we have previously communicated, Charter Arts will be administering the PSATs for all sophomores and other pre-registered students on Wednesday, October 13th, 2021.

At this time, based on the amount of students that are registered to take the PSATs, and as we evaluate our staffing and building space constraints during the Covid-19 pandemic, we want to extend the opportunity for our non-participants to utilize October 13th as an asynchronous learning day to complete coursework as assigned.

If you or your child is interested in taking advantage of this opportunity, please fill out the attached [Google form](#) by 11:59pm on Monday, October 11. To effectively plan for October 13th, Charter Arts needs to know how many non-testing students will be working at home asynchronously and how many still prefer to come into the building. If a form is not submitted, Charter Arts will assume your student will be in the building on October 13th, 2021 and will plan accordingly.

Students who participate in the asynchronous Wednesday will need to submit their daily attendance before 3 p.m. that day via a Google form, which will be emailed to the families who completed the Asynchronous Participation Day form linked above.

Regular bussing will be provided for all students per our Wednesday schedule. Non-testers who come to Charter Arts on the 13th will be assigned to an area within the building to complete coursework asynchronously and will be supervised accordingly.
